It is the policy of the Tully Fire District to provide a systematic transition between our previous elected Fire Chiefs (officers) to the newly elected Fire Chiefs (officers).

At the completion of the election by the Tully Hose Company, No.1 held in December of each year. The Hose Company Secretary will notify the Board of Fire Commissioners of the elected slate of Officers via written notice.

On January 1 all newly elected officers will assume their elected office duties.

At the Annual Organizational Meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioner all newly elected officers will be sworn in and sign the appropriate documents.

Those elected for the position of Chief and Assistant Chief will have five calendar days from January 1 for the installation of equipment into or onto their vehicles owned by the district. This equipment includes but is not limited to, magnetic light bar, radio, and siren.

There will also be a ceremonial "swearing in" of all officers at the annual Hose Company's Installation Dinner held in January.
